# A Trick Question

## Meditation

In today's Gospel, the Pharisees are trying to catch our Lord in His words.

To draw Jesus into their trap, the Pharisees start by flattering Him. "Master," they say, "we know that Thou art truthful, and that Thou teachest the way of God in truth and that Thou carest naught for any man; for Thou dost not regard the person of men" (Mt. 22:16). At first glance, these words appear as magnificent praise, corresponding exactly to reality. Our Lord, who is Truth itself, can only teach the truth. But on the lips of the Pharisees, it is not praise at all. It is a trap they are setting for Him, pure and simple. The next words show this clearly.

The Pharisees continue their statement by asking Jesus, *Is it lawful to give tribute to Caesar, or not?* This is a wily question. If our Lord answers in the negative, as the Pharisees hope, they will be able to deliver Him straight to Pontius Pilate as an enemy of the local ruler. If He answers *yes*, He will offend national feeling, and many Jews will cease to follow Him. If He refuses to answer, His silence will damage His reputation for frankness.

Thus, whatever He does, whatever He says, our Lord will be caught in the trap. However, Jesus is completely unfazed and begins very calmly by

reproaching the Pharisees for their bad faith. "Why do you test Me, you hypocrites?" (Mt. 22:18). Why are you drawing Me onto the shifting sands of politics? Then He shows them the image of Caesar stamped on the denarius which they hold out to Him, and says, "Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's" (Mt. 22:21). In a few words, He turns the situation around and then gives a clear definition of the virtue of justice: to render to God, to the State and to our neighbor what is due to each.

## Resolutions

- 1 To fulfill our duties in the social and political domain with prudence and wisdom.
- 2 To avoid using flattery and deception to draw on us the approval or the good graces of our neighbor.
- 3 To render today to God what is God's, by sanctifying our Sunday through prayer and by paying particular attention to the members of our family.

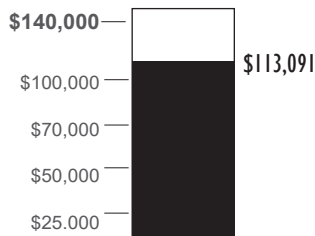
