Meditation: The Two Ends of Marriage

Increase and multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it. —Genesis 1:28

Man and woman are complementary. Therefore, an attraction exists between the two, and we might imagine that the first end of marriage is to fill the void each one feels in solitude. It is not so. The Church affirms that the first end of marriage is not mutual support but the procreation and education of children.

The primary mission of parents therefore consists in bringing into the world the children whom God wills to give to them and in educating those children in a Christian manner, so that they might one day contemplate Him for eternity. The mutual support of the spouses is the secondary end, secondary not in the sense of accessory or negligible, but in the sense that the good of the children should pass before all else.

It is precisely for their children that the parents should try to live in harmony, because children need parents who are united, who are moving in the same direction. There is nothing more anti-pedagogical than division among educators. For children to grow up serenely, they need an atmosphere of peace and they need to hear the same kind of language from their father and from their mother.

Since this harmony between spouses is so capital, it is important to marry someone who shares the same ideals as oneself, to make everything easier. There have to be common and complementary elements, particularly on the essential points, to balance the differences that exist between man and woman and to keep those differences from degenerating into conflict. Anything else is a recipe for disaster.

A person has to have a certain maturity to be able to make so grave a choice. It is always painful to see young people playing with love before they are old enough to marry. They are preparing very sorrowful disappointments for themselves and complicating their lives. Unfortunately, this behavior is not at all uncommon, even in very Catholic families. May these young people open their eyes in time and have the courage to act!
