# Our Lady of the Seven Sorrows

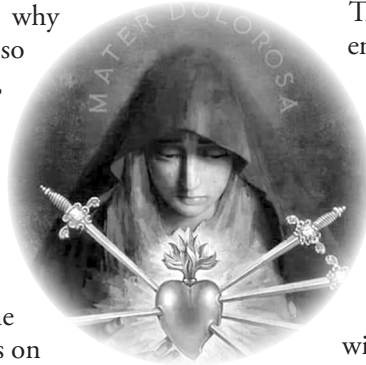
## Meditation

In making her Son's Passion her own, Our Lady did not share the burden that He carried, but carried it entirely. The fact that the two carried it together did not lighten it—far from it!—but considerably increased it. This is why the Blessed Virgin never appeared so great and loving as in that moment, because she never practiced more sublime virtues. St. John writes: "By the cross of Jesus stood His Mother." The closeness of Mother and Son expressed in these few words provides a glimpse of the intensity of their sufferings. The tortures of the Son had repercussions on the heart of the Mother.

Here below there is no deeper love than motherly love. Now Mary is the Mother of Jesus, and she is even mother to a unique degree, since Jesus had no father according to the flesh. His human body came entirely from Our Lady. And so, Mary loves her Son as her very perfect likeness, formed from the purest part of her substance by the working of the Holy Ghost. She also loves Him as her benefactor, as her Savior, to whom she owes all her privileges, from her

Immaculate Conception to her Assumption, and she loves Him with a love that is not only natural, but supernatural.

Her love for Him goes to the point of adoration, because she loves Him not only as her Son, but also as her God. Through their mutual love, Mary and Jesus form one heart.



The intensity of their mutual love enables us to glimpse the intensity of Mary's compassion for the sufferings of Jesus during His Passion. Mary suffers at the sight of His physical sufferings. At the foot of the Cross, she sees the nails that run through His hands and feet, she sees the crown of thorns pressed down upon His head, she sees His face marred with sweat, spittle, and blood.

She too suffers from the ingratitude of mankind, from their forgetfulness about blessings received, and from their disdain. She hears the blasphemies of the chief priests, but she also hears her Son forgive His executioners and entrust to her His last will: "Woman, behold thy son" (Jn. 19:26). After His death, she receives Him in her arms.

Our Lady, you endured this terrible martyrdom for me. Your sufferings, united with those of your Son, are a source of graces. Through your admirable patience, you cry out to me: "Courage, my child! Do not forget that your mother suffered before you! Courage after the pain will come the reward!"
